Tin (Cassiterite) - Solder

Tungsten (Wolframite) - Electronic Devices like cell phones

Tantalum (Columbite-Tantalite) -Capacitor production

or derivatives of these materials that are sourced from DRC (Democratic Republic of the Congo), Uganda, Rwanda, Burundi or Tanzania.
